First go to the association website and submit your Fob Activation Request. Second pick up your fob at the clubhouse at the scheduled dates and times. Activating your fob can take one full business day AFTER you receive your fob.

# **FOB System Replacement**

Early April storms and wind destroyed the FOB system and it is being replaced. The Board had approved the replacement by email earlier in the month.

#### **Pool Rules**

The 2023 pool rules were approved. Kentucky

changed the minimum age for an unaccompanied minor to 17 years. The pool opening is May 27th, and the closing is September 4th.

"Residents are prohibited from feeding animals, with the exception of bird feeders, on their decks and patios or within 30 feet of the buildings due to associated hazards caused by wild animals. "

REQUIRE approval BEFORE any work is done.

# Decks and Rugs - To Cover or Not To Cover

As you know, decks are an on-going and expensive issue. We all need to work together to help maintain and protect the decks.

Can I use a rug on my deck? Yes, but that's only if you Do Not leave the rugs on your deck over an extended duration and use the right type. Rugs hold moisture which can lead to damaging of the surface if you don't change them over time. It would be best to change the cover plan on your deck on occasion

so that some sections are not covered by rugs and furniture all the time. This protects your deck from irregular fading and moisture-actuated issues such as mold growth and rot. Covering the wood deck with an outdoor rug all the time also provides breeding grounds for insects such as wood ants that can damage your deck.

The wrong choice of carpet can leads to scratching, staining, and discoloration.

It is not advisable to use outdoor rugs backed with rubber or latex since they are implicated in the downsides mentioned above.

Outdoor rugs that are safer for wood decks are made from traditionally woven polypropylene or recycled plastic material.

The same holds true for composite decks, since the deck structure is wood. Why would you want a rug on your nice composite deck in the first place.

The Best option is no rug on the deck. If you do—make the right choice.
